# Calling North London Designers and Practitioners; Invitations for participation:

Calling North London based designers and practitioners that have created work in this region to collaborate, create and discuss the future. Designers are invited to submit responses, participate in workshops and submit images of work created in the last four years.

# Audio and Video Responses Call Out

We wish to explore the narrative of designers from different design disciplines in an interactive way, creating an environment that welcomes visitors and creates space for wider discussion.

We will do this by creating a sound and video installation that will be exhibited in Hoxton Hall. It will collate the voices and experiences of designers, making these accessible to the wider public to hear. This will also form a provocation for other designers to respond to in a creative and interactive way and be part of a wider discussion: central to this is the idea that design in itself is ever progressing and not definitive. This will form a part of the collectively produced installation.

We are asking designers to record themselves responding to a series of questions. You can create this recording in any suitable platform that is accessible to you, e.g. voice note, video recording etc.

Responding designers are also welcome to work with us within the project and are invited to the creation workshop on the 4th march to create responses in person for the installation and the exhibition.

The questions below are starting points – you do not need to stick to them if they spark a different direction for your response.

1.How are you feeling today, and why?

- (What could make you feel better or even better?)
- 2. What is one thing that annoys you and why? (can be about design)
- 3. Why (your discipline of) design? Why do you believe it's important in theatre design?
- 4. What is something that you would consider to be the highlight of your career?
- 5. What is something that you would like to achieve? (and how do you think you'll achieve it)
- 6. If you could go back to the start of the pandemic, what would you tell yourself?

7. Has the pandemic changed the way you work or respond to a project brief or creative problem?

8. What's a question you'd like to ask another (your discipline) designer?9. What's your favourite song, noise, sound, texture, colour and how does it make you feel?10. What is your name, profession and something that excites you about what you do?

Bonus question: What do you think is the future of design?
